The Financial Aid Office has recently received information that you are not attending FVCC in the Spring 2019 semester or are registered for less than 6 credits for the Spring 2019 semester. Because of this you have entered your grace period for your student loans and will begin repayment on your loans six months from your last date of half-time attendance.

Federal regulations require that you complete exit counseling. Enclosed, you will find Student Loan Exit Counseling Information. We encourage you to log onto NSLDS so you can see what your total loan debt is at www.nslsds.ed.gov. You can also see your current servicer information.

You will need to complete on-line loan exit counseling by following the directions on the student loan exit counseling information form (the yellow sheet). The on-line loan exit must be completed by **May 1, 2019**.

If you are transferring another institution, you still need to complete the on-line exit counseling for FVCC. Your loans will not enter their grace period until you have stopped attending college at least half-time. Therefore, as long as you are registered in 6 or more credits for the Spring 2019 semester, your loans will not go into repayment until 6 months after your last date of half-time attendance. Also, this will not affect any future loans that you may acquire at your future institution. You should inform your servicer that you are transferring to another institution.
